I realise that I haven't replied to your letter (attached). We should have replied by March 21st. Many apologies for the delay.

I hope an e-mail response will suffice.

Since receiving the second version of the advertising guidance, I was subject to yet another fitness to practise complaint from the GPhC, initiated by the anti homeopathy lobby, concerning several aspects of our web site. My full response of 25/2/2011 is also attached.

In the covering letter to this latest complaint the GPhC clarified their position on the issue of remedy/product listings and their relationship with a purchase facility. I.e

"In respect of allegation 3(I) and 3(II), the GPhC understands from the MHRA guidance that unlicensed products which are not registered under the national or simplified scheme may be listed in either one of two ways. They may be listed with information about the product but there must be no purchase facility OR they may be listed by the product name with no information

As you can see from our response we made another review and more remedial changes to the Helios site. I am awaiting their response to this and a previous similiar complaint we received

about the product and in this instance a purchase facility can be in place."
